Your guide to Staff Cadet Positions and Applying

ADVANCED TRAINING - STAFF CADET

Staff Cadets are senior cadets placed in roles at the Cadet Training Centre to implement and support cadet training. They act as leaders and role models for course cadets and work directly with course cadets on a daily basis. Staff cadets are paid a daily allocation ranging from \$83 to \$101/day and are broken down into the following categories:

<u>Training Staff.</u> Their primary responsibility is to implement training. They act as division/platoon/flight staff and implement course training from cadet arrival until graduation and departure.

<u>Support Staff</u>. Their primary responsibility is to assist and support the implementation of training. Support staff fill various roles including Training Centre Operations, Canteen, Administration, Public Affairs.

Senior Appointments (CPO2/MWO/WO2 and CPO1/CWO/WO1). Selections are completed at the CTC through evaluation and selection boards. These positions provide leadership and guidance to other staff cadets in the completion of their duties and they also act as mentors to their peers and subordinates.

Duration: 7 weeks;

Location: Various;

Training Level: Phase 4/Gold Star/ Level 4;

Age: 16 years old by 1 January of the year of the summer training opportunity and cannot turn 19 before the last day of summer training.

Previous CTC Courses: preference is to complete at least one intermediate or advanced training course.

Waivers: Phase 3/Silver Star/Level 3 cadets or those that have completed a Basic course may be considered but only after all eligible applicants have been selected

Selection Criteria: Cadet Qualifications found in Fortress are used for SCdt selection including current fitness qualification, NSE points, first aid, etc.

Applications Deadline: 1 February. Applications will be accepted after this date, however preference will be give the applications submitted by the deadline.

Email Address: a valid email address for the applicant must be entered into the "Contact Information" section of Fortress. (Note: this should not be the same as parent/guardian contact info email)

How Will I Know If I Am Hired?

Once selections have been made, offers will be emailed to the applicants email address listed in FORTRESS and cc'd to your corps/squadron and Zone Trg O. The email will include a "CTC Staff Cadet Advanced Training Agreement", "Offer of Participation", and tax forms. These will need to be signed and returned, indicating if you accept the offer.

What Positions Are Available?

A list of positions at each of the CTCs is included in this brochure. Many positions are not element specific. Unless applying for QUADRA, Cold Lake Famil Pilot or Cadet Correspondent there is no need to list a specific position on your application. There are some specialty positions available however selection is limited to specialty qualificators or experience.

What Position I Will Be Filling?

In most cases, you will not find out which position you will be filling until after you've completed the pre-course professional development and selection process at the CTC during the first week. Some positions will require specialist skills or training so you may be selected into a "pool" initially.

International Air Cadet Exchange Staff Cadet (IACE-SCdt)

Note: This opportunity is only open to Air Cadets.

Staff cadets accompany the foreign cadets during their visit in Canada. They shall assist the Canadian Host Escort Officers in the performance of their duties. This advanced training opportunity for Air cadets will encourage exchanges between the Canadian cadets and the foreign cadets.

Duration: 21 days (mid July to beginning of Aug); *Location:* TBD

Sqn proficiency level: Level 5 successfully completed by

application deadline.

Age: minimum 17 at the beginning of the advanced trg and not be 19 before the end of the advanced trg; *Rank:* preferably, WO1 or WO2;

CTC Courses: successfully completed IACE or a sixweek course (preferably PPS or GPS); and

Language: at a minimum, ability to communicate in English must be functional. Bilingualism is an asset and must be specified on the application form.
