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COVID-19 Training Precautions

While we have been given the permission to resume in person training it goes without saying that the Squadron Staff are very well aware that we must remain vigilant and ensure our cadets are provided with the safest training opportunities.

First of all, I would like to share with you that all the Squadron Staff have been double vaccinated. Should any new staff be added to our team they will also require the double vaccination before becoming operational. To date, there is no mandatory requirements for cadets to be vaccinated. I would encourage vaccination be considered for you cadet(s) and will leave the matter at that.

The Squadron will be adhering to Provincial PHM and CJCR restrictions.

- We are wearing masks since we do not know of vaccination status of others.
- Only Staff and Cadets are permitted inside the armoury at this time (No parents or Civilians).
- Masks will be worn outdoors if social distancing of 2 Metres or less is not feasible.
- Squadron Attendance will be taken and used as contact tracing registers.
- Classrooms will be sanitized before and after each activity
- The armoury has full-time cleaners who ensure the common areas are sanitized daily.
- Everyone Must to do a self-assessment before attending (Covid Screening Questions). If you are not feeling well, or have been exposed to Covid do not attend. Submit the appropriate absence form
- Cadets are encouraged to use the following link for the assessment:

- The cadets will have their Covid Screening questions verified prior to being allowed to participate in the nightly training activity.
- If a cadet is awaiting covid test results, tests positive, is required to isolate, please inform the Squadron. DO NOT attend cadets.
- There will be no Canteen offered during Monday Evenings at this time.
- The drinking fountains will be only be made available for filling water bottles.
